



A New Highway Bill Will Arrive This Year!

Congress Is Writing the Highway Bill—Will Motorcyclists Be in the Room?

The next federal highway bill is already moving—and if motorcyclists are not physically present in Washington, decisions will be made **without us**.

House Transportation & Infrastructure Chairman Sam Graves has made it clear: a surface transportation reauthorization bill is coming fast. Committees begin work **within weeks**, floor action is expected this spring, and the Highway Trust Fund is on the brink. New revenue sources, new priorities, and new risks for riders are all on the table right now.

This is not a theory.

This is not “someday.”

This is happening before September 30 — and Congress is already negotiating.

That is exactly why **Bikers Inside the Beltway 2026** matters more than ever.

While lawmakers debate funding formulas, infrastructure priorities, and “modernization,” motorcyclists cannot afford to be invisible. History proves it: if riders are not in the room, our safety, access, and freedom get traded away quietly.

The House will act first. The Senate follows soon after. Both chambers are signaling major changes—and they are actively looking for voices to justify their decisions. **Those voices need to be ours.**

- Sit face-to-face with members of Congress and staff
- Demand fair treatment in federal highway policy
- Defend motorcycling access, safety, and rider rights
- Remind Washington that we vote, we organize and we show up

CHECK TWICE - SAVE A LIFE **MOTORCYCLES ARE EVERYWHERE!!!**

Common causes of motor vehicle vs. motorcycle accidents include:

MAKING LEFT TURNS - Before turning **LEFT, CHECK TWICE** to ensure no motorcycle is coming. You're conditioned to look for cars and trucks, and it is easy to 'overlook' an oncoming motorcycle if you're not looking for one.

PULLING OUT - Before pulling out from a parked position, **CHECK TWICE** by turning your head and **LOOKING** for oncoming motorcycles. Motorcycles need more room and space to stop suddenly than a car or truck.

CHANGING LANES - Motorcycles can easily fit in the blind spots of your mirrors. Put your blinker on and **CHECK TWICE**, turn your head to **LOOK** to ensure there is no motorcycle in your blind spot!

SHARING A LANE - Don't share a traffic lane with a motorcycle. Even though a motorcycle is smaller than a car or truck, they are entitled to their entire lane.

DON'T FOLLOW TOO CLOSE behind a motorcycle - a motorcycle needs more room than a car or truck to stop. Keep a good distance behind a motorcycle, leaving enough room for you to stop.

The Lighter Side




Hon,



10 TIPS FOR MOTORCYCLE SAFETY AWARENESS MONTH



For Riders

- 1 Never assume that drivers can or do see you.
- 2 Use extra caution when riding through construction areas.
- 3 Avoid riding in poor weather conditions.
- 4 Position yourself out of a driver's blind spots.
- 5 Use your headlights at night and wear reflective tape.

For Motorists

- 6 Reduce your speed and increase stopping distance.
- 7 Exercise extra caution while at intersections.
- 8 Check your blind spots before making any lane changes.
- 9 Have passengers alert you of a motorcycle rider's presence.
- 10 Stay alert and always be willing to share the road.
